

## Pico - The Grey Island - Activities 2023

Sunvil can pre-book a variety of activities on Pico – see full details below.  
Please note that any pre-booked activity with Sunvil must be requested 14 days or more before departure.



### Guided Walk

The islands of the Azores, with their mild climate (day time temperature ranging from 14-22 degrees), are the most wonderful islands for walking. Our suggested walk incorporates some of the best scenic walks on the island.

### Caminho dos Burros Trail (Half Day)

This 11.2km (3.5 hours) hike to Topo offers a unique view to the south coast of the Island. Discover how Pico Island was originally formed whilst climbing (1022m) the oldest volcano on the Island.

- Difficulty: Grade 2 (Medium)

**Price is £81 per adult and £61 person child (4-12yrs)**

### Notes

- Pick-up from hotels in Madalena (Pico) at about 09:00
- Departures: Daily - all year. Minimum 2 people and maximum 16
- Guided walks with English speaking guide and picnic lunch included
- Recommended: Comfortable clothing, walking boots, swim suit, towel, rain jacket, sun lotion, binoculars and a camera



### **Pico Mountain Hike - Daytime Climb**

For the more adventurous traveller a climb to the summit of Mount Pico can present the opportunity of a lifetime especially if you are blessed with clear skies. The peak, at 2,351 metres, offers spectacular views over the central islands of the archipelago. The ascent generally takes between 3½ and 4½ hours depending on how fit you are and weather conditions along a 5km trail. The climb should only be attempted by strong walkers. The walk is not technically difficult but would involve some steep slopes along uneven paths and in places slippery vegetation and loose stones. The climb starts from 1200 metres. To climb the mountain you must be accompanied by a qualified guide.

- Daily pick-up from hotels in Madalena
- Duration: 8 hours including 3-4 hours uphill
- Difficulty Level: High
- Mountain access fee and walking pole included
- Accompanied by an experienced English speaking guide
- Equipment required: Comfortable, layered clothing (1st layer lycra, 2nd layer polar and 3rd layer waterproof jacket), walking boots, sun lotion, water (min. 1.5 litres), food supplies and a camera



### **Private Taxi Tours**

Sunvil is able to pre-book the following private taxi tours on Pico with an English speaking driver. Tours can also be tailor-made to suit the individual requirements of our clients, please telephone us for a quotation.

### **Pico Island (Full Day)**

Depart from Madalena to the village of São Roque on the north coast of Pico, visiting the black rocks of Cachorro en route. Take the mountain road (altitude 900m) towards the village of Lajes do Pico, which for many years was the centre of the whaling industry in the Azores. Continue on to the Whaler's Museum and home to a fascinating exhibition about the industry. Return to Madalena stopping at 'Verdelho' wine cellar en route.

**Price from Madalena is £165 per taxi**

### Notes

- Pick-up from hotels in Madalena (Pico) at about 09:00
- Prices are based on a maximum of 3 people per taxi
- Full day (7 hours)
- Not included: Lunch and entrance fees to museums and parks
- A qualified English speaking guide can be provided at a supplement on request



### Pico Van Tour - Full Day

Learn all about the historical, cultural and natural characteristics of Pico Island. Experience the striking Unesco World Heritage landscape where you will learn about the viticulture on the Island with a visit to typical wineries. The tour will take you to the central plateau where you will be pleasantly surprised by the green landscape and striking lakes. You will also be introduced to the island's whaling heritage with a visit to the boathouses, whale lookouts and the Whaler's Museum.

**Price is £97 per adult and £73 per child (4-12yrs)**

### Notes

- Minimum 2 people required
- Children 0-3 yrs free of charge
- Included: Transportation, guide service, lunch at a local restaurant and entrance fees at ONE of the following museums: Whaler's Museum, Whale Factory, Wine Museum or Gruta das Torres (Lava cave). Clients will be given a choice locally and the majority vote dictates which museum is visited. If more than one is chosen then there will be a local charge for the additional museums: 5.56 Euros per person for the Wine Museum; 11.11 Euros per person for Gruta das Torres; and 22.22 Euros per person for wine tasting.

### Wine Tour - Full Day

This tour will take you on a voyage of discovery through vineyards and wine production on Pico island. There will be a walk through the vineyards classified as a World Heritage Site by Unesco and where you will learn about the cultural heritage linked to wine production. There will also be time for some wine and liqueur tastings that are produced locally.

**Price is £124 per adult and £93 per child (4-12yrs)**

- Minimum 2 people required
- Children 0-3 yrs free of charge
- Included: Transportation, guide, walking trail at Criação Velha vineyards, wine tasting at the wine cooperative, visit to the coastal areas of Cachorro and Lajido, liqueur tasting at Adega a Buraca and lunch at a local restaurant.



### **Whale & Dolphin Watching Trip - Half Day**

Take a trip of a lifetime on board a Zodiac in search of cetacean activity – 27 of the planet's 80 species of whales and dolphins have been sighted off the coast of the Azores.

**Price is £56 per person (25Mar-07Apr and 09Sep-07Nov),  
£61 per person (06May-07Jul and 19Aug-08Sep) and  
£71 per person (08Apr-05May and 08Jul-18Aug)**

#### **Notes**

- Departures: Daily 3-hour excursions
- Meeting point is Espaço Talassa's base in Lajes do Pico marina departing at 09:00 or 14:00
- Transfers to/from the whaling base are not included
- Minimum child age is 6 years (accompanied by a parent or guardian)
- Briefing by a marine biologist (c.20-minute talk)
- Zodiac boats (small, rigid hull inflatable carrying up to 14 people) are used
- We cannot guarantee that you will see a cetacean but it is unlikely that you should be so unlucky
- Pre-booking in July and August is recommended

**Important:** Children aged 5 years or under, pregnant women or any person suffering from severe back problems are not allowed on the Zodiac boats.

### **Whale & Dolphin Watching - Azorean biodiversity - Full Day**

Join a tour where you will be able to birdwatch from land and sea; search for whales and dolphins in their natural habitat; stop for a picnic lunch; take a short walk on São Jorge Island; and have time to do some snorkelling.
