



## Small Motorboat Hire

The rental of a small motorboat will add an extra dimension to your holiday. It will enable you to explore the local coastline and discover your own small coves and beaches (some may only be accessible from the sea). Take a picnic or simply moor up alongside a different taverna for lunch. In some areas a boat can be more use than a car, sometimes quicker, and certainly more fun!

We can pre-book a boat for you in a number of areas. All necessary safety equipment is provided and no special licence or previous experience is necessary as instruction will be given.

### General Boat Hire Conditions

These conditions may slightly vary from island to island but commonly apply throughout Greece.

Boat hire is not recommended for those with infants under 2 years for safety reasons. For those with small children under 4 years of age please bring buoyancy aids as there may only be a limited supply of life-jackets for younger children.

Boats are intended for exploration of the local coastline – you are not allowed to cross open sea.

Boats are for daytime use only and, unless otherwise mentioned, have to be moored in their home port each evening.

The maximum number of persons for which the boat is licensed must not be exceeded.

Third party insurance is included but damage to the boat or engine is the

hirer's responsibility – in some areas additional insurance can be taken out locally for this.

If you do not use the boat for any reason (e.g. adverse weather) no refund can be given – however our supplier will always try to arrange alternative day(s) subject to boat availability. For this reason we would recommend your boat is booked nearer the start of your holiday than the last few days.

Pre-booked days have to be booked consecutively for the minimum number of days stated, however it is often possible to change these days locally subject to boat availability and adequate notice to the supplier.

Fuel is payable locally, with the exception of Tolon (fuel included). Boats are quite thirsty – for 15hp allow 20 euros per day for fuel.

Boats should be booked at the same time as your holiday – no additional deposit is required.

### Alonissos

Rates are for 6 days hire and must be booked Sat am to Thurs pm

### Corfu – Kalamí

Rates are per day and the minimum hire is 3 days. The daily rate for 20-30hp boats reduces by c 10% on the 7th day of hire

\* Speed boat licence required for 115 hp. Boats need to be returned by 6pm to Kalamí harbour each evening. Boats have a steering wheel, electric start engine, canopy, coolbox and cd player.

### Ithaca

Boats can be hired from Frikes, Vathy or Kioni. Rates are per day and the minimum hire is 3 days, which must be booked either Sun-Tues or Wed-Fri. 6 days hire must be booked Sun-Fri.

Rates are per day and the minimum hire is 3 days, which must be booked either Sun-Tues or Wed-Fri. 6 days hire must be booked Sun-Fri.

Standard Fiscardo boats have pull start engine and tiller steering. Deluxe boats have electric start engine, steering wheel and controls operated from the forward console. All Fiscardo boats are supplied with canopy, a coolbox and mobile phone. **NB - We are also able to book a private luxury motor launch (250hp) with skipper in Fiscardo. Prices start from £71 per person (max eight people).**

### Lefkas & Meganissi

From Nidri, rates are per day and the minimum hire is 3 days

15 hp boats are 4.4m in length and are licensed for up to 4 adults (or 3 adults and 2 small children). 30 hp boats are 5.6m in length and are licensed for up to 6 persons. Boats come with a canopy and cool box. Boats have to be returned to Nidri harbour each evening.

### Lemnos

From Riha Nera beach, rates are per day and the minimum hire is 3 days

Boats are equipped with canopy, cool box, emergency phone, maps and all safety equipment.

### Paxos

From Loggos, rates are per day and the minimum hire is 3 days

Boats come with a canopy and have to be returned to Loggos harbour each evening. Standard is 4.7m in length with two stroke engine. Special is 4.9m in length with four stroke engine. Deluxe is 5.1m in length with four stroke engine plus spare engine of 5 hp, has cd player and cool box.

### Western Pelion

Rates are per day and the minimum hire is 3 days, which must be booked either Sat-Mon or Tue-Thurs.

## Animal Welfare



Animal welfare has long been a troubling issue for many north European visitors to Greece. We are generally unused to seeing stray animals having to fend for themselves, sometimes sick or hungry, and it is a naturally upsetting sight for animal-loving people.

The good news is that, over our nearly 40 years of operating in Greece, we have seen significant improvements. Tourism generally has been a Good Thing for Greek animals - not only because of the taverna left-overs they feed off but because many Greeks have seen and understood a different attitude to animals from their visitors, and this has fed through to the younger generation who, as

a result, are much more aware of animal welfare issues than their parents were. There is also a growing realisation that poor animal welfare is bad for tourism. Combined these influences have had positive results, although there is still much to do.

We as a company, our local representatives and many of our clients have done what we can to help over the years. Many of our reps are actively involved in animal welfare organisations in their area. We have supported organisations in many ways - in Chania, Crete we have bought freezers for food and helped with the expansion and refurbishment of the centre; in Kefalonia we have flown food and medicinal

supplies free of charge from the UK; in Tolon we provide free accommodation for UK vets visiting for the strays sterilisation programme; in Pelion we distribute and collect donation envelopes from our clients.

For 2012 we have joined with the Greek Cat Welfare Society in sending out donation envelopes with our tickets, the idea being that any loose change at the end of your holiday could go inside. Our reps will collect the envelope on behalf of GCWS. Small change soon adds up and can make a significant difference. GCWS is very grateful for any donation, however small, and thanks you in advance.
