Patmos' fame belies its size. This is where St John the Divine wrote the Book of Revelation, and the island hence receives many visitors, most of whom stay for only a few hours before returning to their cruise boat.

It is the most northerly of the Dodecanese and measures little over 20 square miles. Its hilly interior and highly indented coastline means there is plenty of scope for walking and exploration.

The attractive port of Skala is a bustling little place, with elegant arcaded cafés, fine tavernas and some smart shops hidden in the narrow backstreets.

A good bus service runs to beaches and villages, and to Hora and the monastery above. Skala has sand of its own, and caiques leave the quay for other beaches.

High on the hill above Skala is the Monastery of St John, the white houses of Hora clustered below. It is one of the magnificent sights of Greece. Founded in the 11th century,

Getting to Patmos

Thursday Day flight Gatwick or Manchester to Samos (note: inbound Gatwick flight via Lemnos). Then 3-3½ hours by ferry. For flight details see page 173.

Transfer Note

Due to limited sea connections we include an overnight on Samos on arrival and/or departure, normally in a small BB hotel in the pleasant port of Pythagorion. All transfers are included. In 2011 the ferry departed Samos on Fridays at 16:15 and departed Patmos on Wednesdays at 10:50. Two-centre clients will overnight only once, at the start or end depending on the itinerary.

Flowers and shrubs surround this highly praised accommodation, which has a beautiful freshwater swimming pool in the gardens (over 100 sq. m. depths 1.1m – 2.6m). It is in a quiet corner of Skala 500m (no hills) from the harbour.

The seven studios are mostly ground floor. They are furnished tastefully with twin or double beds, kitchenette area with cooking rings, mini-oven and fridge, and tiled shower/ wc. A couple are maisonette-style with a sleeping gallery above. The studios have a sitting-out area in the garden.



Hora

The four detached cottages are further up the garden. Each has two bedrooms (or one bedroom and a sleeping gallery), spacious living room, a kitchen (open-plan or separate) with cooking rings and oven, and tiled shower room. Each has a spacious covered verandah to the front overlooking the colourful gardens and pool. Most bedrooms contain twin beds, but one has a double. The houses are cool and roomy – most can take a child on a sofa-bed in the living room area. Décor and furnishings are tasteful and of good quality.

All the cottages and studios have hairdryer, safety deposit box (free) and air-conditioning available on request at a local charge of 8 Euros per day per studio and 15 Euros per cottage.
