Options include any number of variations upon the sailing theme.

**Cabin Charter:** this gives the flexibility to do as much or as little as each person wishes – this is, after all, your holiday. It can be an introduction to yachting for those who want a 'hands-on' experience; a structured sailing course for those wanting certification and prepared to put more effort in; or pure, unadulterated relaxation for those who just want to be a passenger.

**Flotilla Sailing:** sailing in the company of other yachts.

**Bareboat Charter:** for the experienced sailors who just want to be on their own.

**Dayboat Hire:** for those staying ashore but who would like some time afloat either with or without a professional skipper aboard.



Our many types of sailing holiday operate from the Hotel Armonia, near Nidri on Lefkas, where we have our own pontoon directly outside the hotel on which our yachts are moored. Lefkas is often hailed as the 'sailing capital' of Greece, and with good reason. The sheltered waters, favourable wind conditions and safe anchorages in the heart of some stunning island scenery make this part of the Ionian Sea ideal for both the novice and experienced sailor.

The programme has been designed to combine easily with our regular holidays on dry land, so a week or two staying in any of our accommodation on Lefkas or Meganissi Islands, or our resorts of Parga and Sivota just up the coast, can be added without breaking the bank (please enquire for prices).

### Representative

We have our own sailing staff based at the Armonia Hotel and a representative based in Nidri.

## Flotilla

A flotilla is a group of yachts sailing in company, and this holiday option combines the freedom of sailing with the security of a group and lead-boat guide. We require the skipper to have at least an ICC certificate plus a Practical Yacht Skipper Certificate or equivalent experience, and at least one other crew member must be up to a Yacht Crew level of experience.

Our normal Cabin Charter and Flotilla route is run throughout the season (May to October) and usually takes in the islands of Lefkas, Meganissi, Kalomo, Kastos, Ithaca, Kefalonia, a few of the smaller islands, and occasionally mainland Greece. We also operate a two-week Cabin Charter and Flotilla route, on certain dates, which go much further into the Sea of Corinth and which allow for non-sailing days to do some sightseeing in such stops as Delphi and Messolongi (where Lord Byron, supporting the Greeks in their war of independence against the Ottomans, died).

## Price Guide per Flotilla/Bareboat Yacht:

From £1000 for a 6-berth (2-cabin) yacht per week, £1300 for an 8-berth (3-cabin) yacht pw, £1900 for a 9/10-berth (4-cabin) yacht pw and £3000 for a 10/12-berth (5-cabin) yacht pw. All these are as an add-on to a shore-based package. Please note there is a local on-site charge to cover welcome starter pack, linen, fuel, yacht damage waiver, cleaning etc. Please contact us for a bespoke quote for a standalone flotilla/bareboat package including flights and transfers.

# Cabin Charter & Tuition

## Price Guide per Cabin Charter

All cabins are doubles (except aboard some of the larger 4-cabin yachts which also have at least one twin bunk cabin) and prices are per cabin with two-person occupancy – in brackets is the price for single occupancy.

From £600 per cabin per week in low season (£450 pw sole occupancy) to £1000 per cabin per week in peak season (£750 pw sole occupancy).

Please note there is a local on-site charge to cover welcome starter pack, linen, certification and sundries depending on the programme booked.

## Two-Day multiples Shore-Based Options – with skipper/instructor

This is an ideal package for anyone who ever wondered what it would be like to sail a yacht. It is also perfect for the experienced (but rusty) skipper – with an ICC - wanting a brush-up prior to going on flotilla or wanting to introduce his/her family to sailing. You normally join the yacht at about 0930 hrs after breakfast, and return at about 1730 hrs. Lunch (which is not included in the price) will be taken either ashore in a nearby port or as an on-board picnic. The courses/boat hire run every week Mon-Tue, Wed-Thur or Fri-Sat, and can be easily combined.

## Price guide per boat – 2-5 persons

From £320 low season to £390 peak season per two-days for the whole yacht with a skipper/instructor aboard.

## Two-Day multiples Shore-Based Options – self-sail for experienced dinghy/yacht sailors

## Price guide per boat – 2-6 persons

From £200 low season to £280 peak season per two-days for the whole yacht  
 From £380 low season to £490 peak season per four-days for the whole yacht  
 From £530 low season to £650 peak season per six-days for the whole yacht  
 (These can be split over two weeks ie 2 days week one and 2 or 4 days week two)

## Terms and Conditions relating to Holidays including any Sailing Elements

### Cancellation

Cancellations where a 'yachting' element is part of the booking, the whole amount of the 'yachting' element cost is lost if cancelled within 48 days of departure. 'Yachting element' refers to Flotilla, Bareboat and Learn-to-Sail (both live-aboard and shore-based).

### Additional Clauses:

(a) To minimise delays to departure of yachts in Greece we will complete and sign the 'Greek Charter Party Agreement' on the charterer's behalf (copy available on request) together with 'Declaration of Charterer's Ability to Skipper a Yacht' now required by the port police. We cannot be held responsible for any incorrect information provided either directly

or through an agent and the charterer's signature (either as skipper or on behalf of the skipper) on our booking form (or electronic acceptance) confirms acceptance and agreement with this procedure. This will also apply to any similar procedure required in any of our other destinations.

(b) Please complete the medical section of the booking form honestly, any illness or disability does not necessarily preclude someone from taking part.

(c) The issuing of certificates is solely at the discretion of the instructor and reflects the student's ability. In all situations and cases the decision of the professional skipper(s) is final.

(d) A sailing week consists of six sailing days. In the eventuality of loss of sailing due to staff or mechanical problems, proven to be our responsibility, which exceeds six hours between 0900 hrs and 1900 hrs we will refund one sixth of

the weekly yacht charter price paid for each day lost, or offer equivalent compensation. This is purely based on the charter price of the yacht and does not include any element for flights, accommodation etc. A substitute yacht, if offered, must be accepted.

(e) We reserve the right to either prevent a charterer from taking a yacht out to sea by themselves or to put one of our skippers aboard at the charterer's expense if the charterer's experience of skippering a yacht is not satisfactory or not as stated on the booking form.

(f) Our yachts are registered for commercial use in the country within which they operate, and all on-board safety equipment has to conform to that country's requirements.

(g) All descriptions and information given in our printed and electronic literature form part of our terms and conditions.

# Additional Information

## REQUIRED FROM ANYONE BOOKING A HOLIDAY WITH A SAILING ELEMENT

All the information requested must be supplied in order to satisfy our insurers and the local port authorities that issue the paperwork enabling our yachts to put out to sea. There may be an administration charge for any missing information that we have to continuously chase up. Failing to supply this information could result in your not being able to participate in the sailing holiday once on site. Travel agents, please note that this information also applies to you and we have to have the clients full contact details as requested on the main booking form. In the case of a group on a Learn-to-Sail holiday, we have to have the full contact details for everyone in the party, not just the party leader.
