Highlights of the Faroe Islands

The Faroe Islands lend themselves perfectly to touring holidays with stunning, unspoiled scenery set within the wild North Atlantic Ocean. This is a destination with immense appeal for nature lovers, bird watchers and walkers.

Day One:

On arrival at Vagar airport, you will be transferred to the Hotel Tórshavn.

Day Two – Four:

Days at leisure in Tórshavn. Opportunity to enjoy a guided tour of the capital city; take a cruise on board a schooner; and visit the cultural centre of Kirkjubøur.

We would also recommend a day excursion to the southernmost island of Suderoy, approximately 2 hours voyage by car ferry. This island is famous for its dramatic west coast landscape. You can easily pass a day meandering around this peaceful island before heading back to Tórshavn on the afternoon ferry.

If Suderoy doesn't take your fancy, why not try the smaller island of Sandoy (25-minutes by car ferry)? Each of the 18 islands of the Faroes has its own character and Sandoy is the 'agricultural island' where the landscape is of rolling hillsides and farmland.

Day Five:

In the morning a car will be delivered to your hotel. Spend the afternoon exploring the islands of Streymoy and Eysturoy en route to the village of Gjógv and the Gjaargardur guesthouse.

Days Six – Seven:

Days at leisure in Gjógv, a paradise for artists and a place from which to escape from the rest of the world.

Day Eight:

In the morning drive to Vágar airport for your return flight to the UK.

Guided Excursions in the Faroe Islands

Guided walking tour of Mykines Mykines is rich in birdlife and is renowned for its Puffin colony, and during this tour there is the opportunity to get close to these wonderful creatures (weather conditions permitting).

Transfer to Mykines by ferry from Sørvágur. On arrival on Mykines you will meet the local guide, and depart on an unforgettable trip of this beautiful island.

The landscape covered on the walk consists of spectacular headlands where grassy slopes rise steeply from sea level on one side, before dropping off as a sheer cliff on the other. These cliffs are home to dense colonies of Fulmars, Gannets, Guillemots, Razorbills and Kittiwakes, and the grass slopes hold Puffin burrows – a spectacular sight.

Duration: 3 hours

Included: Boat transfers between Sørvágur and Mykines, guide on Mykines, coffee and biscuits

Notes:

- This excursion may be private or part of a group, depending on the number of people booked.
- Due to changeable weather conditions, the length of time spent on Mykines is subject to change.
- The walk is approximately 7 miles long and has many small climbs and descents, some of which are on cliff edges (these have steel ropes and steps).
- Transfers to/from Sørvágur harbour are not included. Transfers can be arranged at a supplement.
- Due to the mountainous terrain this excursion is not suitable for those with walking difficulties.

Boat trip from Vestmanna to the sea cliffs of Eiði Depart from Vestmanna and journey along the west coast of Streymoy to Eiði on the north coast of Eysturoy. This excursion passes through narrow sounds, into deep grottoes, carved by the ocean throughout the ages and alongside soaring cliffs.

During the summer months these cliffs provide safe nesting places for thousands of sea birds, notably Puffins, Razorbills and Guillemots.
