Winter delights - 7 nights:

Travelling from Luleå, close to the Finnish border, to the town of Kiruna, 200km north of the Arctic Circle this 7-night itinerary can be adapted to be as active or as relaxed as desired. Tours of the frozen Bay of Bothnia by hovercraft; dog sled and reindeer sled excursions; snowmobile tours and Northern Light excursions can be included.

A highlight of the tour is the overnight stay at the world famous ICEHOTEL in Jukkasjärvi, where everything from the art work, to the chairs you sit on, the beds you sleep on, and the glass in your hand is made using carefully harvested, crystal clear ice.
