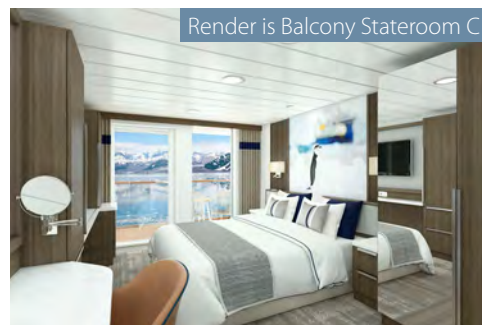

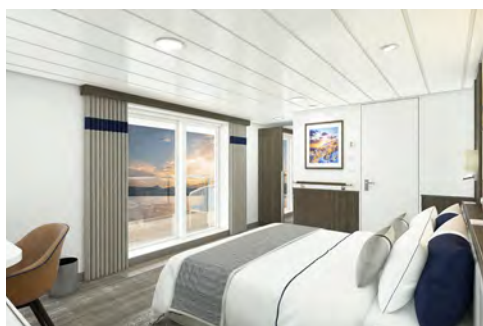

Stateroom and private balcony combined size 45.22m², balcony, bathroom and lounge.













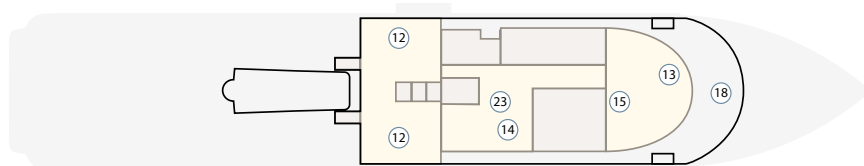
