SYLVIA EARLE

Our second new purpose-built small ship expedition vessel honours the highly accomplished marine biologist, oceanographer and explorer, Dr. Sylvia Earle. As the first woman to become chief scientist of the U.S. National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, and named by *Time* Magazine as its first "Hero for the Planet" in 1998 – this vessel pays tribute to Dr. Earle's long-standing conservation efforts for marine protected areas and ocean wildlife.

Like the *Greg Mortimer* ship, the *Sylvia Earle* also features the revolutionary Ulstein X-Bow® for faster, smoother sailing and contains a unique glass atrium lounge inside the bow for stunning panoramic views. The ship also features a jacuzzi, where you can admire impressive scenery while watching the world go by from the top deck.


