Gulet cruises

Gulets are wooden schooners that are used to offer small group and private cruises in the Mediterranean, most synonymous with Greece and Turkey. The size of the vessel means that you are never more than a couple of metres from the water's edge and can lay anchor in bays inaccessible by larger boats... the result is an intimate and authentic experience.



Our chosen provider, Sail In Greece, operates a collection of nine gulets and seasonal departures. We feature their seven night itineraries from Corfu and Rhodes either as a flight plus cruise holiday package or as part of a longer cruise and beach-stay. The average number of guests is 25 per sailing.

Each night is in a different port (see below) and sailings include breakfast and lunch (buffet), one captain's dinner, daily swims, use of SUPs, kayaks and snorkeling equipment, A/C* and WiFi*. Cabins are cosy and simple, with shower - with your incredible natural surroundings you will only use your room to sleep.

Optional excursions are on offer (at a supplement): guided tours, wine tasting, cooking classes and watersports.
