The largest of the Greek islands, Crete is a land of myth and history, of dramatic mountains, fertile valleys and glorious beaches. At the same time sophisticated and elemental, Crete is unique.

Kalives

First settled by humans 130,000 years ago and positioned between Africa and Europe, Crete was the cradle of Mediterranean civilisation and still retains its own strong identity and culture, characterised by a history of proud resistance against invaders through the ages.

Rich in its physical contrasts, the island has always been the source of legend and adventure. Fascinating archeological remains are sited all over the island, from the colourful

reinvention of Knossos to the arid mystery of Phaestos. Three separate mountain ranges riven with spectacular gorges and rivers stretch from west to east, with lush valleys falling to a varied coast of small fishing villages and magnificent sandy beaches.

An absorbing mix of Minoan, Venetian and Turkish architecture, the island's towns weave together palaces, churches, castles, and minarets alongside the bustle of markets, cafés and tavernas.

NEROKOURO

Although just nine kilometres from Chania there are no signs of tourism in Nerokouro: a church, a mini-market, a small bakery; a friendly community and beautiful views over valleys towards Souda Bay. Souda Bay with its supermarkets, fresh fish stalls, cafes and tavernas is only 5 minutes' drive away.

VAMOS

Vamos is really a small town with many folk and neoclassical architectural influences. There are some very interesting buildings in the village, notably the churches of Agios Nikolaos and Agios Georgios and the restored school, originally built in 1863. Twenty six kilometres from Chania, the village has narrow cobblestone streets and lanes passing by interesting and attractive stone houses. There is a large square shaded by plane trees. The beaches of Kalives are 6km away. Vamos has a good selection of traditional tavernas, coffee shops, post office, bank, chemist and a variety of small shops.

VRISSES

A very well situated, working village with a backdrop of the White Mountains and about 30 minutes drive to either of the two main towns of Rethymnon and Chania in the west

of Crete. The sandy beaches of Georgopolis are about a 15 minute drive and the dramatically located village of Chora Sfakion on the south coast a 45 minute drive across The White Mountains. Many gorges and small villages are in the vicinity making Vrisses an excellent base from which to walk in the area and also to explore the whole of western Crete by car.

The village has a good selection of tavernas, a cafenion, a butcher, two bakers, a couple of mini-markets and even a bank and pharmacy.

KALIVES

About 20km east of Chania and at the entrance of the dramatic Souda Bay, Kalives has retained its village atmosphere and boasts two long sandy beaches, one to either side. Centred around a tree-shaded square, housing a couple of cafes and a fine church, Kalives has authentic local tavernas and small shops which cater for most needs.

The village has a population of 1,400 and in Byzantine towns was the likely site of Kissamos, one of the ancient city of Aptera's two harbours. To one side of the village is the sea and behind low hills covered by orange and olive groves with the dramatic White Mountains in the background.

A highly recommended spot, with easy access to atmospheric Chania, the Venetian built main town in the west of Crete.

THERISSO

At 580 metres above sea level, 14 km from Chanea and accessed through the stunning, picturesque Therisso Gorge, the village was a centre for the struggle against the Turks. In 1905 it was the headquarters for Venizelos in the drive for union of Crete with Greece. Tavernas and restaurants abound in Therisso and the in the neighbouring villages of Zouvra, Drakona and Meskla. There are several picturesque walks and drives across the mountins.

STYLOS

The modern village of Stylos is 23 km from Chania and 2 km from the town and beaches of Kalives. Several tavernas are set around streams that run through the village, making it a refreshing place to sit and eat. There is one mini-market in the village. There are many walks around Stylos and the Diktamos Gorge begins here. For the curious, next to the church of St. John, the fossilized remains of a Cretan dwarf elephant, Palaeoloxodon Chaniensis, can seen.

At first glance, Villa Stella seems to grow straight out of the landscape. As you walk around the beautiful grounds of the property you're greeted with stunning views of Souda Bay. Enjoy the total privacy of these shaded terraces, where you can enjoy an evening glass of wine or cook a barbecue for an al fresco dinner. It's the perfect couple's retreat, though the steep 50m walk from the car parking area to the villa means it can be a slight challenge for those with mobility problems. This romantic retreat is in the charming village of Nerokourou, away from the busier tourist hubs nearby. There's a mini-market in the village, but the nearest tavernas are in the towns of Chania or Souda. Drive a little further to Kalives for some of the island's best beaches.

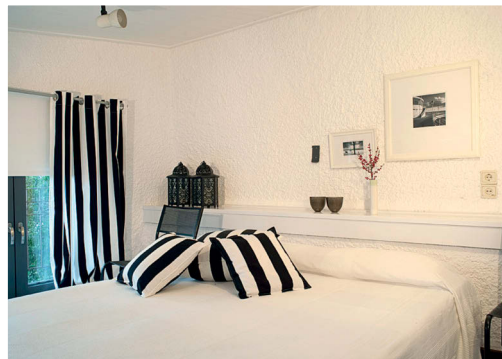

VILLA STATHIS

VAMOS • CRETE

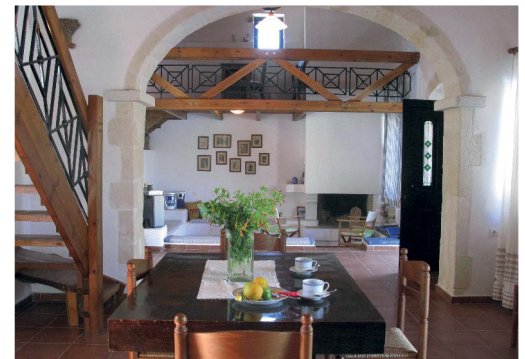

VILLA APHRODITE

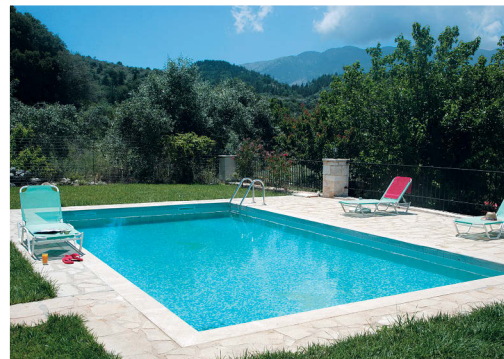
NEAR VRISSES • CRETE

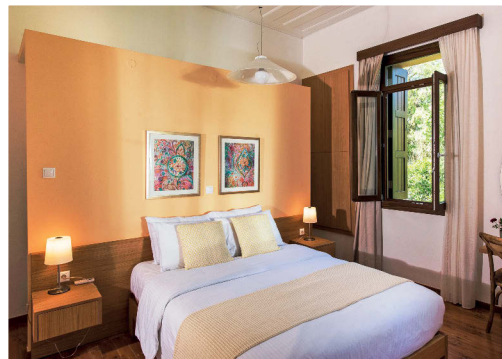

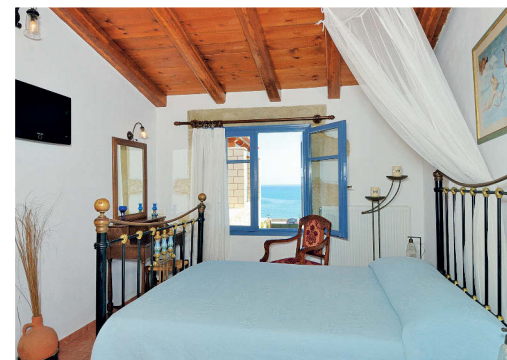

VILLA MARIS

NEAR VRISSES • CRETE

Head just five minutes by car from the quaint little village of Vrisses into the foothills of the White Mountains, and a small track will lead you to Villa Maris. This house is striking, with spacious rooms, traditional décor and French doors leading from the bedrooms onto balconies. Yet it's the panoramic views around that leave guests in awe – 360-degree vistas of vineyards and farms, olive groves and pine forests nestled below the great peaks.

Grassy gardens and an expansive patio wrap around the stone-built villa, with the large swimming pool taking pride of place. There are pretty fruit orchards, an impressive outdoor kitchen with barbecue and pizza oven, and a welcome shaded eating area that looks over both the pool and sweeping landscape.

If you can tear yourself away from Villa Maris, the nearby National Road provides easy access to northwest Crete's sights, while the lovely sandy beaches of Georgioupolis are just 10 minutes' drive away. Meanwhile, the rugged south coast is under an hour's drive.

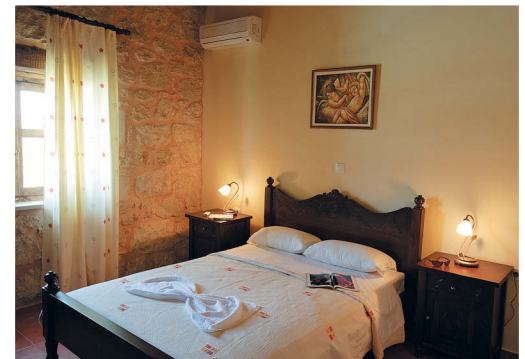

For those in search of total tranquillity, Villa Therisso is the ideal Cretan escape. The village of Therisso might be just 16 kilometres south of Chania, but it's a world away from the hustle and bustle of the city, tucked away at the far end of a stunning gorge in the foothills of the White Mountains.

The villa is delightful, with classic charm, and light and airy rooms. Fling the windows open and let the smell of pine trees breeze through, lie in bed and enjoy dramatic views of the peaks and valleys through the open French doors, or enjoy a romantic breakfast on the little balcony. Indoors and outdoors blend beautifully at Villa Therisso, with an inviting swimming pool, barbecue area and series of terraces – perfect for family meals under the stars and days splashing around.

Therisso might not have a supermarket, but it is well-stocked in tavernas and cafes, and has a fascinating World War II history, along with a museum on Eleftherios Venizelos, the Cretan Prime Minister responsible for reuniting Crete with mainland Greece after 400 years of Turkish rule.

Explore a hidden corner of Crete along quiet tracks, where the sound of sheep bells floats on the air, walk the six-kilometre Diktamos Gorge, which passes through rugged mountain landscapes and farms. Stylos River House is ideal for couples or families in search of a modern villa where they can unwind and explore.
