




Panama

One of the more off-the-beaten-track destinations, Panama offers the adventurous traveller a chance to visit untouched islands, mesmeric cloud forests, misty highlands, tropical rainforests, volcanic craters and abundant wildlife amidst the continent's most independent indigenous people. Hike, bike or kayak around forested islands that have an infectious Afro-Caribbean charm.



At a glance

- Panama Canal - the world's greatest short cut and an engineering marvel
- Lake Gatún – one of the largest man-made lakes in the world
- Varied and beautiful landscapes – cloud forest, rainforest, tropical beaches and mountain ranges
- Boquete – the “town of eternal spring”, cool, fresh and inviting
- Panama City – visit Casco Viejo, the old city, with its cobblestones and colonial architecture
- Dry Season from December to April, but can be visited all year round
- Various ethnic communities with distinct heritages
- Macaws, toucans, squirrel monkeys and sloths

Getting there

Flights from London Heathrow to Panama City with KLM (via Amsterdam), Air France (via Paris) and Iberia Airlines (via Madrid). In addition, Avianca operate a service from London Heathrow (via Bogota). Regional departures include Manchester, Birmingham, Cardiff, Bristol, Humberside, Newcastle and Edinburgh.


Combinations

Panama City


Located on the Pacific coast, Panama City is only a stone's throw away from some of Central America's richest rainforests. It is a vibrant, cosmopolitan city, combining old Spain with modern America; from the 16th century ruins of Casco Viejo, to the 17th century Spanish colonial churches of Casco Antiguo, to the 'Manhattan-like' skyscrapers. No visit to the city is complete without a transit through the engineering marvel of the Panama Canal.



The Bristol

Canopy Tower

Soberania National Park **FB**

The Canopy Tower is a unique lodge set in the heart of the Soberania National Park. A former US Air Force radar station, it has a rooftop viewing deck that offers breathtaking 360° views over the surrounding canopy. The 12 rooms, situated on the first and second floor, are modest yet comfortable with large windows, ceiling fans and bathrooms.

Boquete

A one hour flight from Panama City, followed by a 1 hour drive from David Airport will bring you to the cloud forest village of Boquete. Set on the slopes of the extinct Baru Volcano - this picturesque mountain village is located in one of the most beautiful, pristine regions of the country. It is a wonderful environment for those seeking complete immersion in nature and is perfect for walking or bird watching. The area is home to vast coffee plantations producing the country's finest coffee.



Finca Lérida
Boquete **BB**

The lodge is set within a 800 acre private nature reserve. There are twenty two spacious and attractive double rooms, each with private bathroom, porch and stunning views of the valley and surrounding mountains. After a day of birding, hiking, walking or just relaxing, guests can enjoy a variety of freshly cooked meals in La Brulerie Restaurant.



Azuero Peninsula

This beautiful and remote region is known for its' pristine beaches and strong folkloric traditions. Dotted with old colonial towns and nature reserves hosting wetland birds and nesting turtles. One of Panama's oldest settlements, the city of Chitré is the cultural and historic capital of the region and is a pleasant stop on the way to the peninsulas' beaches. Further down the peninsula is the historic settlement of Pedasi, which is the best place from which to visit the nearby wildlife reserve on Isla Iguana.

Cubita is a convenient base from which to explore the region. The facilities include the Los Maizales Restaurant and a circular swimming pool with an adjacent pool bar. There are 96 air-conditioned rooms and suites, all with private facilities and a balcony or terrace with views of the internal patio, colonial chapel or swimming pool.
