

Guatemala boasts beautiful Spanish colonial towns, rainforests, renowned archaeological sites such as Tikal, serene lakes and a fascinating indigenous population. Traditional villages come alive with their colourful markets, and cloud-shrouded highland communities seem little changed in centuries. You can scale volcanic peaks, explore rainforests and ruins, soak up the culture or simply relax on the shores of a stunning lake.

# Getting there

There are flights from London Heathrow to Guatemala with Iberia (via Madrid), American Airlines (via Miami) and United (via Houston or Newark).

Guatemala and Costa Rica provides a perfect mix. For those looking for a beach stay we can include the island of Ambergris Caye in Belize.



Antigua is an attractive UNESCO colonial gem with a charming ambience and laid-back charm. Due to an 18th century earthquake, it now sits gracefully ruined with toppled church arches, courtyards, and flowers and fountains galore. It lies in the shadows of three volcanoes and million-dollar views. The main square attracts everyone from shoe-shiners to ice-cream vendors.



Antigua BB Panza Verde is a charming colonial boutique hotel. It is a short distance from the main plaza and Cathedral. There are 12 en suite rooms (9 suites and 3 standard) decorated with antiques. There is an elegant restaurant with vaulted ceilings, plunge pool, garden and various seating areas. There is a large rooftop terrace with lovely views.

## Lake Atitlan

The focus of the Highland region is the beautiful deep-blue Lake Atitlan. Formed by an incredible explosion that blew the top of a volcanic mountain, leaving only the crater behind. Traditional villages inhabited by descendants of the Maya are dotted around the lake. There are several renowned markets and plenty of adventure activities on the lake shores - kayaking, trekking and biking are possible here.

This property enjoys a wonderful location on the banks of the lake and has a relaxing and homely ambience. The beautifully maintained gardens are an abundance of colourful flowers and exotic birds. The 62 rooms are furnished with local fabrics and artwork and have a balcony and a view of the gardens or lake. The restaurant, pool and jacuzzi overlook the lake.

### OUR TOP TIPS

A trip to nearby Santiago Atitlan and the wooden idol of Maximon is worth a visit • Chichicastenango is famous for its touristy market. However, with locals in traditional dress this is much more than just a shopping experience!



### Peten - Tikal National Park

Deep in the lush lowland jungles of the Peten lie the lost worlds of Maya cities and pyramids. The mighty temples in the vast Tikal National Park poke through the top of the surrounding jungle canopy. On the northern shore of Lake Yaxha is the impressive site of Yaxha where it is possible to climb to the top of one of the temples and admire the wonderful sunset! The town of Flores is perched on a tiny island in Lake Peten-Itza.



# Camino Real Tikal

This contemporary hotel is located on the shores of Lake Peten-Itza. All 72 thatched bungalow rooms have air-conditioning, safe-deposit box, mini-bar, TV and private balconies. There is a pool, gym, restaurant, bar and gardens.

### Ambergris Caye

Ambergris Caye is the largest of some 200 islands that dot the coastline of Belize. Sun drenched and fringed with coconut palms, stretching alongside the second largest barrier reef in the world. An excellent location for diving, snorkelling or simply lying in a hammock between the coconut trees and sipping a cocktail. The laid-back town of San Pedro has a good choice of restaurants and bars. The warm waters are a paradise for water-sport enthusiasts with a multitude of activities on offer such as sea kayaking and windsurfing.

### Ambergris Caye BB

Victoria House is an elegant yet informal resort hotel located on a sandy beach. This plantation-style property is set amongst mature gardens planted with coconut trees and bougainvillea. The 42 en suite rooms include the standard state rooms, palm-thatched casitas, luxury suites and private villas. There is also a cocktail bar, two pools, spa, gym and a jetty. A long-standing Sunvil favourite.

Take a short flight from Flores (Guatemala) to Belize city and then an onward flight to San Pedro (Ambergris Caye) • Entry from the shore is often not possible due to sea-grass. We recommend swimming from the piers instead
