





Venezuela

Unusual and undervisited, Venezuela has a magnificent Caribbean coastline, tranquil offshore islands, snow-capped mountains, savannahs rich in wildlife, extraordinary vertical table-top mountains, gigantic waterfalls and uninhabited rainforests. With tourism in its infancy, it offers a rare opportunity for genuine discovery.

At a glance

- Angel Falls – the highest waterfall in the world (979m), best visited during wet season, June-September
- Canaima National Park – sixth largest on the planet
- Fabulous beaches (many almost deserted) along Caribbean coastline and Los Roques archipelago
- Wetlands with caimans, piranhas and anacondas
- Unique flat-topped mountains (“tepui” – house of the gods)
- Superb wildlife observation at Los Llanos
- Tourism is in its infancy
- Accommodation generally simple and rustic
- Flights from London Heathrow (via Frankfurt or Madrid) to Caracas

Suggested itineraries

Including private transfers, excursions and internal flights. A number of the lodges are on a full board basis due to their remote location. Full itinerary, hotels and prices on request.

Highlights of Venezuela 13 nights

- Fly into and return from Caracas.
- Caracas 1 night – modern city stopover for connecting flights
- Los Llanos 3 nights – Low-lying savannah plains superb for general wildlife observation. Off the beaten track safari experience.
- Gran Sabana 4 nights (escorted small group inc. one night in gateway city) – vast, wild and beautiful. Characterised by over 100 large distinctive table-top mountains and countless waterfalls.
- Canaima 2 nights – stunning tannin-coloured lagoon with 6 waterfalls. Base for boat trips to Angel falls (May to January only).
- Los Roques 3 nights – marine national park. Archipelago of 41 pristine and unspoilt cays surrounding a huge lagoon. Excellent place for bone fishing and water-based activities. Gran Roque is the only inhabited island. All lodges include daily transfers to nearby islands.

Alternative Venezuela 15 nights

- Fly into and return from Caracas.
- Caracas 1 night - modern city stopover for connecting flights
- Choroní 3 nights – Nestles between Henri-Pittier National Park and palm-fringed beaches. Charming town with a few narrow streets and pastel painted houses.
- Los Llanos 3 nights - Low-lying savannah plains superb for general wildlife observation. Off the beaten track safari experience.
- Puerto Ordaz 1 night – convenient stopover point before proceeding to Canaima
- Canaima 3 nights - stunning tannin-coloured lagoon with 6 waterfalls. Base for boat trips to Angel falls (May to January only).
- Los Roques 4 nights - marine national park. Archipelago of 41 pristine and unspoilt cays surrounding a huge lagoon. Excellent place for bone fishing and water-based activities. Gran Roque is the only inhabited island. All lodges include daily transfers to nearby islands.
