

Copenhagen

The city of Copenhagen is located on the island of Zealand, almost at the easternmost point of Denmark, and is one of Europe's oldest and most wonderful capitals.

1 Nyhavn

Not to be missed on any visit to Copenhagen is Nyhavn (new harbour), the colourful harbour that features on postcards and in every guidebook. A favourite place for locals and visitors alike.



2 Nørrebro

Nørrebro is the real Copenhagen. Here you will find atmospheric lanes, squares with impromptu street entertainment, an oasis of shops and restaurants and the Assistens Cemetery.

3 Cycling

The streets of Copenhagen are awash with bikes. It is the original bike city with 400km of bike lanes criss-crossing the capital. It is the best way to explore the compact capital's famous landmarks.



4 Architecture

For architectural gems, look no further than the Black Diamond – an angular extension of the Royal Danish Library, the modern Opera House and the stock exchange, Børsen with its spire of four entwined dragons.

Copenhagen

At the centre of Copenhagen is the district of Indre By (the inner city), bounded by parkland and a myriad of lakes, canals and waterways. This is the historical heart of Copenhagen jam-packed with medieval buildings, colourful harbours, narrow cobbled streets and Royal Palaces.
