### Challenge park

### Eight season photo tour

In Sámi culture the year falls into eight seasons: spring-winter; spring; pre-summer; summer; pre-autumn; autumn; pre-autumn and winter. These seasons are based on the cycles of nature, in particular the yearly cycle of reindeer, and are not defined by date or time.

On this 4 hour excursion, you will learn to capture the ever-changing landscape of Swedish Lapland, the animals and local culture, on camera. With a local guide, you will explore your surroundings by car and, occasionally, on foot stopping at scenic and panoramic locations en route. Tea and coffee is included.

**Midnight Sun**

The Midnight Sun shines continuously above Jukkasjarvi for 100 days and nights. Yet from the end of May until the end of July, the sun only sets below the horizon for a short time, and daylight barely dims.

On this 3 hour tour, you will visit the nearby city of Kiruna and learn about life in the land of the Midnight Sun. Kiruna is a city in transition and is slowly being moved to a new location to allow for the expansion of its iron ore mine. Your tour will finish at the summit of Mount Luossavaara where, from your elevated position, you can watch the arch of the sun moving across the sky.

The Midnight Sun is guaranteed to stir emotions in all visitors.

**Northern Lights safari**

Many people associate the dazzling displays of the Aurora Borealis with the winter months. It is however, possible to witness this magical phenomenon from the end of August. In fact, in our opinion, the colours of fall and autumnal foliage coupled with dark nights and the Northern Lights is a combination that is hard to beat.

On this 3 hour tour, along with a local guide, you will travel away from the artificial lights of Jukkasjarvi to a wilderness camp. Here you will learn truth and myths about the Northern Lights and enjoy a Swedish fika (coffee and cake).

**Sauna ritual**

In Swedish Lapland, the sauna is the heart of the home. Enjoy for yourself the warmth of the sauna, following a 10 step sauna ritual - finishing, like the locals, with a dip in the river, on this 2½ hour experience. A thorough cleansing of mind and body.

### Torne River rafting

The Torne River for centuries was the lifeline for Swedish Lapland transporting goods and people across the region. On this 6 hour tour, you will travel along the flowing river on a rafting experience. Calm and white-water will be crossed. Lunch and all equipment are provided.

- Departures: 10:00 from 14Jun-03Sep17 (Wednesdays and Saturdays)
- **Price: £141.00 per adult**

### Wilderness dinner

Enjoy a delicious three course evening meal at the ICEHOTEL's wilderness camp. No matter the time of year of your visit, this is a delightful experience which will allow you to immerse yourself in the pristine natural beauty of Swedish Lapland, albeit for a short time.

Canoes, cross-country bikes, stand up paddle boards (SUPs) and fishing equipment can be rented for a half day or full day. Maps and instructions regarding the best areas to go will be offered locally.

- Duration: 8 hours (Full day) and 4 hours (Half day) from 15May-31Oct17 (Daily)
- Canoes, cross-country bikes, SUP paddle boards and fishing equipment (including licence) are all the same price
- **Local cost: 395 SEK per person (Full day) or 295 SEK (Half day)**
