

Sweden Car Hire Terms and Conditions 2016

Included in your Avis rental:

1. Unlimited mileage.
2. Collision Damage Insurance Cover. In the event of an accident this insurance covers the full value of the vehicle. However you remain liable for the excess amount of 7500 SEK (All Groups). Please note that this insurance does not cover damage to the vehicle's tyres, undercarriage or windscreen.
3. Theft Cover Insurance. In the event that the rental vehicle is stolen this insurance covers the full value of the vehicle. However you remain liable for the excess amount of 7500 SEK (All Groups).
4. All local taxes and airport/city surcharges.
5. LAF (Vehicle Licensee Fee) and VAT at 25%.
6. Winter tyres are provided from 01Dec-30Mar.

Not included (payable locally):

1. Super Collision Damage Waiver Insurance and Super Theft Protection Insurance can be purchased together locally at a rate of 119 SEK. By purchasing the SCDW and STP Insurance, the excess payable in the event of an accident or theft is void.
2. Personal Accident Insurance (PAI). This insurance costs 25-40 SEK per day. Please note that Sunvil travel insurance provides limited personal insurance and covers medical costs. If you have not purchased Sunvil travel insurance, please check with your insurance company prior to departure to see if you will be covered.
3. Toll road administration fees where applicable. These are charged to the driver on return of the vehicle.
4. Each additional driver will be charged locally at a rate of 40 SEK per day (maximum of 400 SEK per rental).
5. Infant and booster seats are now compulsory for children up to 12yrs (or a height of 135m). Infant and booster seats 125 SEK per day (maximum 500 SEK per rental). An additional charge of 375 SEK applies to one-way rentals.
6. GPS Navigation System equipment is available on request at a rate of 125 SEK per day (maximum of 625 SEK per rental). An additional charge of 375 SEK applies to one-way rentals.
7. Any applicable one-way charges. One way charges range from 625 SEK within 200km, 938 SEK between 201-400km and 1250 SEK between 401-600km.
8. Any applicable after hours airport charges. The after hours charge is from 500 SEK between 00:00-06:00 Monday to Saturday. Higher charges apply on Sundays and public holidays.
9. Any applicable delivery and collection charges. Delivery and collection, within 10km of an Avis office, is on request and available free of charge during office hours. Deliveries further than 10km incur a charge of 25 SEK per extra km. Outside of office hours a charge of 500 SEK is payable plus 25 SEK for extra km.

Notes:

1. Cars will be supplied with a full tank of petrol. A credit card imprint will be taken to cover a deposit, local extras or any excess charges. The deposit will be refunded when the car is returned with a full tank of fuel. Please note that the credit card needs to be in the same name as the designated driver.
2. A full, valid UK, EU or international driving licence, issued not less than one year prior to rental is required.
3. Driving is on the right.
4. Minimum age for drivers is 21yrs (Groups A, B, C & D). No maximum age.
5. We can request, but cannot guarantee a particular make of car or engine size.
6. Permission to drive the rental vehicle into Denmark and Norway subject to approval at the time of booking.
7. We are not liable for any police or traffic fines incurred by clients.
8. These conditions also apply to car hire already included in the cost of our holiday. All local charges quoted here include VAT (25%).

9. Our insurance does not cover any personal belongings stolen while unattended in a hire car, unless in a locked and covered compartment (valuables are not covered).
10. Airports are open 365 days a year.
11. Please advise us, at the time of booking, of any ENDORSEMENTS ON YOUR LICENCE.

IMPORTANT: New procedures for hiring a car abroad

From 08-Jun-2015, the paper counterpart of the UK driver's licence was abolished by the DVLA and details of your driving restrictions and penalties stored electronically. For those of us who plan to hire a car, in the UK and abroad, we are now required to grant the car hire company access to our stored data through a simple two-step procedure on the DVLA's '**Share Driving Licence**' portal. The new procedure is quick and easy to follow (instructions below), generating a synopsis of your licence and a unique eight digit check code for your rental company to use.

This procedure must be completed no more than 21 days before each rental period.

Instructions:

- Click on 'view now'.
- Enter your driving licence number, National Insurance number and your postcode.
- Click on share your licence information.
- A unique, one-time code will be generated. This code will need to be provided to the car rental company along with your photo card licence.
- You can also save and download the summary of your driving licence produced. This document can be saved on your smart phone for ease of access.
- Repeat the above process for all drivers.

Important: If you do not have a driving licence with a photo card, you do not need to follow this procedure.

Whilst some of our car rental partners have confirmed that they will not require the check code, we feel that it is important for all drivers to complete this procedure for peace of mind. Excess Car Insurance

More people are now purchasing Excess Insurance before they travel, finding it better value if renting for more than 7 days, or hiring a car abroad more than once a year. A number of companies such as www.insurance4carhire.com offer this product. This insurance covers not only the insurance excess but also the underside of the car, windows and tyres. Please ensure you have all necessary receipts before you leave the country should you need to make a claim, as you will have to pay and claim it back on your return to the UK.
